

PASTOR'S CORNER

"You cannot be my disciple unless you hate..."

- - Luke 14:25-33


How can Jesus, a man of love and peace, speak of hate for parents or families? The word "hate" here is not to be taken literally. He means that no love in life can compare with the love we must have for Him. To be a true disciple means to prefer Christ above all other relationships and possessions. We cannot be a disciple without the Cross. To prefer Christ above all may create tensions in the family, at work, or among friends. It is not that you love them less, but you love Christ more.

For young people, it is a call to "prefer Christ" in a culture that does not value chastity and abstinence. For parents, it is a call to "prefer Christ" in a culture where states still legalize abortion. For business people, it is a call to "prefer Christ" in a culture that seeks to gain a profit by unethical practices.

Jesus calls us to calculate the cost of discipleship - to follow His ways. Morality is becoming more and more difficult and challenging. Yet that is why we have come here today...to seek the grace that makes us true disciples. May we, as a faith community, be another source of grace, supporting and encouraging each other in all of the ways of discipleship.

May we keep in mind these words from St. John Paul II:

"In comparison to the love of Christ, everything is secondary; and without the love of Christ, everything is useless."

- Are baptized Catholics who have not yet received the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation
- Are married to a Catholic and attend Mass, and would like to take the next steps to become a member of the Catholic Church

OCIA is a spiritual formation process beginning in October and ending with initiation in the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. OCIA classes are taught by Father Murray and are held every Monday evening from 7:00-8:30pm at the rectory. These classes are for anyone with interest, no matter what your current denomination. 

ST. HILARY'S EAGLES FOOTBALL BLOCK POOL



The pool will include the final 16 games of our PHILADELPHIA EAGLES season, and will raise funds for our parish.



1st game will be Week #2 on Sunday, 9/14/25 vs KC Chiefs!





Here is how it works: Blocks will be sold for \$80 each



(\$5 per week, for 16 weeks). Semi-annual payment plan will be available.

The pool administrator will randomly place your names on the 1st week's grid, until the grid is full. That grid will then be copied for all 16 weeks.

Your designated block stays the same all season.

At that time, numbers from 0 to 9 will be randomly chosen for each week, for both, the Eagles and their opponent.

The numbers along the top and side will be different each week, so each block has the same chance of winning. The completed blocks will be circulated through email, and hard copies will be available before the opening game kickoff.

The score at the end of regulation (not OT) will be used to decide each week's winner. The unit digit from each team's score will be used as lookups to determine the winning participant. For example, EAGLES 41 vs New England PATSIES 33, we would use Eagles 1 and PATSIES 3 as the lookups. Each weekly winner will receive \$250 sent out by the pool's administrator. We estimate that the parish will pay out \$4,000 in prizes, and make \$4,000 to offset a variety of costs, for each grid of 100 blocks.
