

PASTOR'S CORNER

"By your perseverance, you will secure your lives."

- - Luke 21:19

There is a chill in the air; the light of day is diminishing and autumn leaves have been falling. Life is changing once again. To prepare for winter, we usually take appropriate actions...checking the furnace, winterizing the car, unpacking heavy clothes, etc. Today in the gospel, Jesus urges us to note the changes in our lives. All things pass away and we, too, are part of that process.

The writer, Mitch Albom, once wrote, "Everyone knows they're going to die but no one believes it. If we did, we would do things much differently." To deny death is a lack of humility. In the face of this, Jesus gives us His blessed assurance. There is a season beyond death - the season of Resurrection. Like us, Jesus was caught up in the changes & turmoil of life. He was victimized by evil men, suffered greatly, and died a terrible death. Yet what remains constant and certain in all of this was that He knew God always has the final say. His faith was rewarded; His story did not end on the Cross but continues in His Resurrection.

None of us know the day nor the hour when we will dance with death. Yet we can prepare to meet it head on. Remain a people of trusting faith...devoted to God and also embracing His eternal truths and values. The day of the Lord is coming like a blazing fire. His fire is a fire of love and mercy that will burn away all fear and all that is incomplete in us. God has the last word, and for those who remain faithful to Him, that Word will be a cause of true joy.

All Saints...Did you know?

In our three altars, the relics of six saints can be found. In the Main Altar is found the relics of Saint Verecundus and Saint Severianus, martyrs. In the Blessed Mother Altar are the relics of Saint Aurelia and St. Timothy, martyrs. And in the St. Joseph Altar are the relics of Saint Sixtus and Saint Perpetua, martyrs.

The relics of the saints are placed in altars to honor the saints as heroic witnesses to the faith and to connect the Mass to the early church's practice of celebrating in catacombs among martyr's tombs. This practice celebrates that the sacrifice of Christ celebrated on the altar is connected to the sacrifice of the martyrs who shed their blood for Christ.

The relics are also a reminder that the saints' lives were sacred temples of the Holy Spirit and their bodies are worthy of respect.


