The aggregate results of the 2025 survey will be compared to our parish results from 2022 and new opportunities will be explored to further improve our parish community.

This is a BLOCK POOL (same as our Eagles block pools). NO SKILL NEEDED... RANDOM LUCK. March Madness is the name given to the NCAA Men's Div. 1 Basketball Tournament that decides our National Champion. The tournament format consists of multiple rounds of games, with a single loss elimination format (only winning team advances). Our pool will consist of 31 games (**31 chances to win**). We will NOT use the 1st Round games in our pool. Our 1st games, the 2nd Round of the tournament, will be March 22 & 23.

Here is how it works: There are 100 blocks on each grid. Each block will cost \$50. The pool administrator will randomly place your names on the grid, until the grid is full (hopefully we will sell multiple grids). At that time, numbers from 0 to 9 will be randomly assigned for each column (top) and each row (left side). These numbers will remain the same and be used for all 31 games that we are including in our pool. This format makes it possible for a block to win multiple times. Each block has the same chance of winning. The score at the end of regulation (not overtime) will be used to decide each game's winner. The numbers across the top of the grid represent the winning team. The numbers down the left side of the grid represent the losing team. The unit digit from each team's score will be used as lookups to determine the winning block. For example, St Joseph 61 Duke 47, we would use St Joseph 1 and Duke 7 as the lookups. St Joe would be the column, and Duke would be the row.

The completed blocks will be circulated through email and hard copies will be available before March 22. For each grid, the Parish will pay out \$3,000 in prizes, and make \$2,000 to offset a variety of costs. *** **Deadline is March 18**. Thanks for your support!
