
## PASTOR'S CORNER

-- John 6:1-15

The disciples once again are facing a big dilemma. Thousands of people come from near and far to listen to the man from Nazareth. However, no one brought any provisions or food. For the disciples, their best solution was "send everyone home." There was no human solution to the situation. Then came a little boy offering his meager amount of loaves & fishes. ## UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

 Now that June is over, we are now completing our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. A total of \$427,176.25 had been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$401,500. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 201 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoy our new air conditioning system in the Church. Our children and teachers kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. Thank you to those who are still paying toward their pledge. ### **John 6:1-15; Loaves and Fishes**

This Gospel passage records the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and the fishes. The crowds following Jesus were hungry, so Jesus asked Philip where they could get enough food. Philip calculated that two hundred days' wages still wouldn't buy enough food for them. Like Philip, we face problems that seem too big for us and can become intimidated.

The Apostle, Andrew, went a step further than Philip; he found the boy with five loaves of barley bread and two fish. The boy, in turn, offered to Jesus what little he brought - all of it. What a surprise when Jesus fed the five thousand "as much...as they wanted." Even after they'd had their fill of bread, there were still twelve wicker baskets left over! God can't be outdone in generosity.

When we are faced with many problems at once, it can be overwhelming. It's easy to react like Philip and give up hope. While on our own, we may not have much to offer; if we offer what we have to God, He can do something amazing with it.


