## PASTOR'S CORNER

**"Do whatever He tells you."**

*John 2:1-11*

Today, Jesus comes to the rescue of a newly married couple's wedding reception. At the prompting of His Mother, Mary, Jesus transforms water into wine. It was not just any kind of wine, but the choicest and best that delighted the taste of everyone.

What took place at Cana is a sign of Jesus' ministry. He came to transform human life. He gave us new standards, improving our quality of living. He makes life taste better by allowing us to participate in divine life. We live in a culture where faith and morality are running out. The world holds up an inferior image of humanity...an image that excludes any reference to God. Such an image leaves us wanting for something better, something more.

We have just entered Ordinary Time  
in our Liturgical Year...



### What Ordinary Time Means in the Catholic Church

Because the term “ordinary” in English most often means something that’s not special or distinctive, many people think that Ordinary Time refers to parts of the calendar of the Catholic Church that are unimportant. Even though the season of Ordinary Time makes up most of the liturgical year in the Catholic Church, the fact that Ordinary Time refers to those periods that fall outside of the major liturgical seasons reinforces this impression. Yet, Ordinary Time is far from either unimportant or uninteresting.

### Why is Ordinary Time Called Ordinary?

Ordinary Time is called “ordinary” not because it is common but simply because the weeks of Ordinary Time are numbered. The Latin word “ordinalis” which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word “ordo” from which we get the English word “Order.” Thus, the numbered weeks of Ordinary Time, in fact, represent the ordered life of the Church, the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) or in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ. It’s appropriate, therefore, that the Gospel for the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time always features either John the Baptist’s acknowledgement of Christ as the Lamb of God or Christ’s first miracle ~ the transformation of water into wine at the wedding at Cana. Thus, for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives.

There's nothing “ordinary” about that!





### THREE TIPS TO BOOST YOUR PRAYER

*Prayer fuels our spiritual life, but praying effectively can be challenging sometimes. Even the saints had dry spells. Among these was the mystic and Carmelite reformer, St. Teresa of Avila. Try these suggestions from her to enliven your prayer:*

- \* **Become aware of God's presence.** It may feel as if God is distant, but He is so close. St. Teresa began by enjoying God's nearness. Know that He is with you and wants your company.
- \* **Bring a good book.** St. Teresa, who struggles with dryness in prayer, kept a book with her. Scripture, Lives of the Saints, or a book about the Faith can help us focus and spark conversation with Him.
- \* **Be honest.** It is said that St. Teresa once fell into the mud and told God bluntly, "If this is how you treat your friends, no wonder you have so few of them!" God wants you to share all your experiences with Him - good and bad. Entrust your cares to Him.


