



PASTOR'S CORNER

"Stay with us."

The gospel tells us of two disciples in a state of despair. All their hopes in Jesus seemed shattered by His crucifixion and death. We find them walking toward a setting sun, and then a Stranger appears. He walks with them, listening and breaking open the sacred scriptures. As He appears to depart from them, they pray, "Stay with us; the day is over and evening draws near." The Stranger stays and breaks bread with them and they realize it is Jesus, the Risen Lord.

We all have such stories when our hopes are diminished and shattered. The hard knocks of life happen...perhaps the death of a loved one, betrayal, unexpected sickness, family crisis, etc. In such moments, this same Stranger is walking with us. Jesus waits to hear our prayer, "Stay with us." He is here, present in the sacrament of the Eucharist. We are called to change direction and walk toward the rising sun, the Son of God. No situation is beyond His reach. Jesus overcame the most impossible situation - death itself. In those dying-like moments of life, He is here to raise you up. As the great Easter prayer reminds us:

*"He is the One who broke the chain of death and rose triumphant from the grave.
Christ is the morning star who comes back to shed His light on all, the Son who lives and reigns forever and ever."*

THANKS to this parish community for the tremendous support for the 2022 St. Hilary Diamond Jubilee Capital Campaign. Seeing the progression of this campaign these past months has been truly a blessing. We have an exciting update; this campaign has

raised **\$407,191.25**. Through your prayers and help, we have even surpassed our initial goal of \$350,000. The sooner that the pledges are redeemed, the better it will be for paying for these projects. Of the 229 campaign responses, 141 are now paid in full. We currently have about \$287,730 of the campaign contributions already deposited, and it is imperative that we continue to collect all payments on pledges to ensure that we can complete all the capital work.
