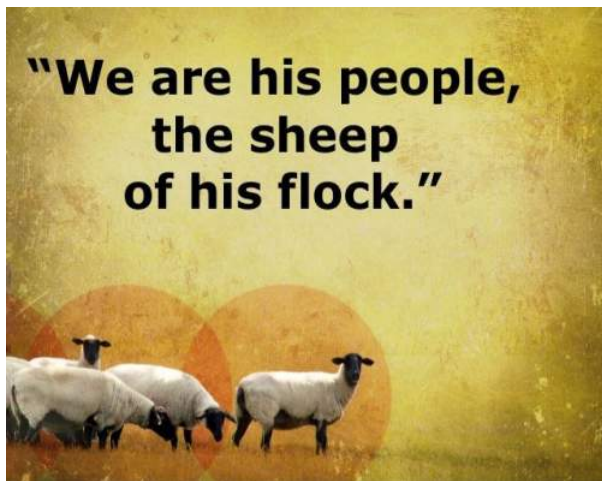


PASTOR'S CORNER

I am very happy to announce that Archbishop Perez has appointed a new Pastor and Administrator to St. Hilary's. He is someone very close to us and has been with us for many years. Please welcome Msgr. Gregory Fairbanks to our parish community in this new leadership role. Msgr. Fairbanks served many roles in the Archdiocese. He was ordained in 1990 and his first assignment was Parochial Vicar at Christ the King Parish in Philadelphia. He served as a Chaplain at Temple University and then was sent for graduate studies in Church History at the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. Upon returning to Philadelphia, he taught Church History at the Seminary and directed the Archdiocesan Office of Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs. In 2008, he was called to serve at the Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity in Rome. In 2015 he returned to St. Charles Seminary, teaching Church History, and since 2020 he has directed the Permanent Deacon Formation Program.

Msgr. Fairbanks brings a wealth of pastoral experience that will serve our parish well. I am very happy to welcome Msgr., who is a faithful and dedicated priest, and I wish him many long and happy years here in our wonderful St. Hilary faith community. Please join me in welcoming him!

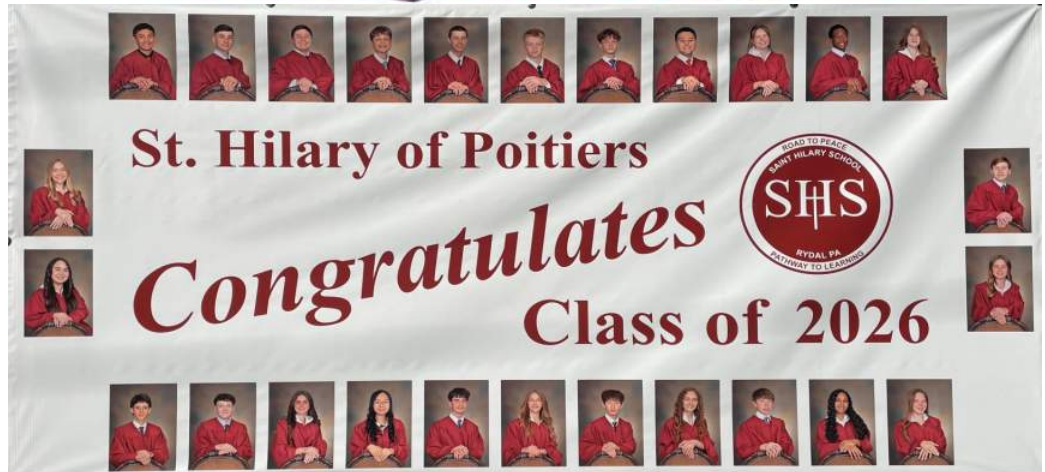
