



PASTOR'S CORNER

The crowning moment for any athlete comes when victory is finally achieved and he or she holds up a prized trophy. The long quest is celebrated by holding the trophy high, kissing and embracing it, like a long lost friend. The trophy for Jesus Christ was His Cross. The prize He won was for all of us...victory over death, resurrection, and new life. The hour of Jesus' greatest humiliation was the hour of His greatest triumph.

How many times in our hardest and most trying moments - moments of pain & desperation - we are drawn to that painful image found on a Crucifix. We may catch ourselves reverencing the Crucifix with a holy kiss or blessing ourselves over and over again. Ironically, when we need new life, hope, and strength, we come to the image of Jesus crucified. We come believing that His cries and tears were heard in an extraordinary way. Sorrow, suffering, and even death were transformed by Jesus' great victory of Resurrection. To the degree that we join our cries and tears to Him, we, too, will transcend our sorrows and defeat the deadly forces of life.

In our final days of Lent and as we soon approach Holy Week, may our life and love be ever drawn near to Him. May we fill the Church with reverence and devotion so as to learn to triumph over all adversity. May we allow His grace to conquer what long has conquered us.

UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

This coming June, we will complete our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. Currently a total of \$427,176.25 has been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$347,948 so far. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 168 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoyed our new air conditioning system in the Church in summer. Our children and teachers were kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. So, as we are nearing the end of our Campaign, I am most grateful for your kind generosity. As always, the people of St. Hilary always come through! God's grace and peace.

Friday ~ the King is coming; clean the house in order to prepare for Palm Sunday


Saturday ~ praying for the dead is a work of mercy; visit a cemetery and pray for the souls there

NOVENA TO ST. JOSEPH


The Feast of St. Joseph is March 19. You can use this prayer to receive the help of this great man...
