PASTOR'S CORNER

"He was led into the desert by the Spirit"
- Luke 4:1

Jesus begins His forty days in the desert and we follow Him there by our forty days of Lent. Lent is a time of fasting and sacrifice, a small gesture of trying to show appreciation and thanks for Jesus' self-sacrifice on the Cross.

Yet Jesus went to the desert not just to fast but to feast. Yes, He fasted from bread but feasted on God's holy word. He fasted from power and prominence but feasted on the joy of service and humility. He fasted from self-sufficiency but feasted on His dependency on God.

THREE PILLARS OF LENT

The three pillars of Lent are prayer, fasting, & almsgiving (acts of charity). Lent is a realistic down-to-earth time. It's about ashes and the cross. It's about money, food, and how I spend my time. It's about sin and sorrow. It's about life and death.



One of the Prefaces in the 1974 Sacramentary used for Lenten Masses thanked God because "each year you give us this joyful season when we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery with mind and heart renewed." Joyful? That seems strange for Lent.

But it's like an exercise program. At the very beginning, you're sore all over, yet you also feel invigorated, energized, enlivened...and you really feel good about yourself. Your body is made for this.

So it is with Lent. Our penitential practices may be hard at times, but they lift our inner spirit. We're made for more than TV reruns or computer games.

We are made for the unimaginable greatness of God.

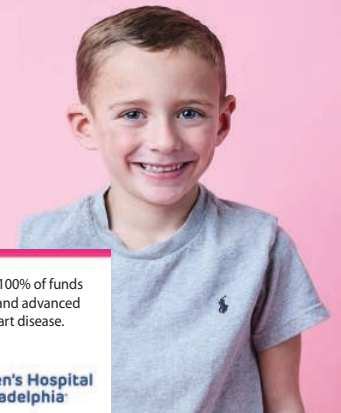
