

PASTOR'S CORNER

"We proclaim Christ crucified a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles."


-- 1 Corinthians 1:22-25

In the early days of Christianity, proclaiming Jesus Christ as the power and wisdom of God was mocked and ridiculed. After all, Jesus Christ was crucified and hung on a Cross. Men of virtue and heroes were not found on Crosses. Crosses were reserved for pretenders, traitors, and criminals. Yet as St. Paul writes, "The apparent weakness and foolishness of a crucified Messiah proved more powerful than any worldly wisdom. Christ's folly proved wiser than any human wisdom."

Today, the world still views Christ's message as foolish. The Ten Commandments seem all but forgotten. They are viewed more as ten "suggestions" than commandments. Yet, how refreshing they are to read and hear again today. They are like a rich oasis in a hot desert of moral decadence. The Psalmist says it best, "They are sweeter than honey or syrup from the comb; perfect and refreshing the soul."

Jesus today cleanses the temple of its worldliness. He can also to cleanse the temple of our bodies and rededicate ourselves to those time-tested values of the Ten Commandments. Jesus will always be a contradiction to the world's moral view. Yet, His "foolishness and weakness" brought us new life. Let us pray to be fools for Christ and to have the courage to become weak like Him. Then, we will discover a folly wiser than any human wisdom, and a weakness more powerful than any human strength.

UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



This coming June, we will complete our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. Currently a total of \$427,176.25 has been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$347,948. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 168 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoyed our new air conditioning system in the Church in summer. Our children and teachers were kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. So, as we are in the second year of our Campaign, I am most grateful for your kind generosity. As always, the people of St. Hilary always come through! God's grace and peace.

A VERY SPECIAL BANK ACCOUNT

Imagine that you had a bank account that deposited \$86,400 each morning. The account carries over no balance from day to day, allows you to keep no cash balance, and every evening cancels whatever part of the amount you had failed to use during the day. What would you do? Draw out every dollar each day?

We all have such a bank. Its name is Time. Every morning, it credits you with 86,400 seconds. Every night, it writes off, as lost, whatever time you have failed to use wisely. It carries over no balance from day to day. It allows no overdraft, so you can't borrow against yourself or use more time than you have. Each day, the account starts fresh. Each night, it destroys unused time. If you fail to use the day's deposits, it's your loss and you can't appeal to get it back.

There is never any borrowing time. You can't take a loan out on your time or against someone else's time. The time you have is the time you have, and that is that. Time management is yours to decide how you spend the time, just as with money you decide how you spend the money. It is never the case of us not having enough time to do things, but the case of whether we want to do them and where they fall in our priorities.
