PASTOR'S CORNER


"He humbled Himself... To a point of death, even death on a cross."

Philippians 2:6-11

The Passion of the Lord proclaimed this Palm Sunday comprises two important points. The first is the event - Christ suffered and died, giving over His body and shedding his blood. The second is the motivation - this can be found in just two words..."for you!"

If we forget the why and the motivation, then Jesus' Passion is just a historical fact, disconnected from our personal lives. The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent, and on Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

Palm Sunday

What will you do with your palm?

The palm brought home today is to be used to remind you that Jesus is worthy of praise ~ today and always. Place the palm behind a crucifix or picture of Jesus in your home or perhaps in some other place where you will see it day after day and be reminded to cry out, “Hosanna to King Jesus!”



Here are some suggestions for remaining days of Lent:

Sunday ~ when listening to the Gospel readings at Mass, imagine yourself in the scene

Monday ~ pray for all those coming into the Church at the Easter Vigil

Tuesday ~ forgive anyone who has hurt you; ask forgiveness of anyone you have harmed

Wednesday ~ reflect on your Lent; where did you grow and what graces did you receive?

THREE DAYS OF WORSHIP

Holy Thursday celebrates the Mass of the Lord's Supper in the evening, commemorating the institution of the Eucharist and the priesthood. Christ's new commandment to love one another is recalled in the Washing the Feet. That love becomes fully realized in the Eucharist and Christ's sacrifice on Calvary.

On **Good Friday**, the Church gathers in silence to read Scripture and offer prayers for the whole world. The Veneration of the Cross takes place not simply to mourn Jesus' suffering and death but to acknowledge that through the cross of Jesus, we are led to glory.

The **Easter Vigil** is the high point of the entire Church liturgical year. The new fire is blessed and candles glow in the celebration of Christ as our light. Salvation history is proclaimed through Scriptures, climaxing in the joyous proclamation that Christ has risen. Those who have been prepared for baptism enter the Church & all Catholics renew their baptismal promises.

Missionary Hubs in the Archdiocese

On January 5, 2025, Arch. Perez released a pastoral letter regarding the future of the Church of Philadelphia. In it, he discussed 2 primary challenges facing the church today - the first problem is many of our fellow Catholics have drifted away from the church and do not regularly attend Mass. In fact, 83% of baptized Catholics don't come to church. The second problem is that there continues to be a shortage of priests across the Archdiocese. In his letter, he reiterates that he did not become the Archbishop to close parishes; he came here to "build up the Church of Philadelphia." In an attempt to reverse the trend and build up the church, he announced the creation of Missionary Hubs across the diocese. A hub is an initiative planted in a local community, most likely within an existing parish setting. It will be focused on missionary outreach for a region within a county and serve a group of existing parishes. It will include various Catholic ministries and invite people into a relationship with Jesus Christ. A hub is designed to help our parish communities focus on the 83% of those who don't come through the church doors. Missionary Hubs are not intended to replace existing parishes. Rather, they are designed to enrich, supplement, and actively support parish life. Hubs are meant to work alongside and in collaboration with existing parishes. In cases where there are not sufficient priests to assign to each parish, parishes served by the Missionary Hub may be led by a Parish Life Director instead of a priest. The Archdiocese has created a website with more info and videos about this change, which the Archbishop plans to roll out in phases over the next decade. You can access the website at trustandhope.org.




