



## PASTOR'S CORNER

**"I am the vine and you are the branches"**

## UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



This coming June, we will complete our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. Currently a total of \$427,176.25 has been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$354,013. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 172 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoyed our new air conditioning system in the Church in summer. Our children and teachers were kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. So, as we are in the second year of our Campaign, I am most grateful for your generosity. As always, the people of St. Hilary always come through! *God's grace & peace, Fr. Murray*



*The goal of a Catholic Liturgy is to Communicate a transcendent awareness of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ. Faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist demands great beauty, dignity, and reverence".*

At the Last Supper, Jesus said, "This is my body... this is the cup of my blood" (Matthew 26:26-28) over the bread and wine, and so it was. He commanded His Apostles, and the priests after them, to do the same at every Mass (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #1375)

When we receive Communion, we're literally heart-to-heart with Jesus. The details are a mystery, but that doesn't stop Jesus from coming to us, Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, in the Eucharist.



In this year of reviving our devotion to the Eucharist and encouraging everyone to return to Mass, we will offer weekly meditations, reflections, and poetry from various saints and authors on the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, which is "the source and summit of the Christian life." Excerpts are taken from the book *The Holy Hour*, a Word on Fire publication.

### **Reflection by Pope Francis in a Homily from 2018:**

*In life, we constantly need to be fed - nourished not only with food, but also with plans and affection, hopes, and desires. We hunger to be loved. But the finest gifts, the most pleasing compliments, and the most advanced technologies are not enough; they never completely satisfy us. The Eucharist is simple food, like bread, yet it is the only food that satisfies, for **there is no greater love**. There we encounter Jesus really; we share his life and we feel his love. There you can realize that his death and Resurrection are for you. And when you worship Jesus in the Eucharist, you receive from him the Holy Spirit and you find peace and joy. Let us choose this food of life! Let us make Mass our priority! Let us rediscover Eucharistic Adoration in our communities!*

**WHAT WAS MUSIC LIKE IN THE EARLY CHURCH? DID THEY USE HARPS AND CYMBALS LIKE KING DAVID?**

Music in the early Church was a quiet affair, as we can easily understand when we think of the Roman persecutions that lasted 300 years. Catholics could hardly sing and play instruments at full volume during that time!

The Eastern Church - in Syria and Greece - wrote and sang hymns early on, but it was not until St. Hilary of Poitiers and St. Ambrose of Milan in the latter half of the 4th century that hymns traveled westward. St. Hilary spent time among the Eastern Churches, and their hymns inspired him to write similar songs in Latin, set to a classic Latin meter.

After St. Hilary, St. Ambrose of Milan took up writing music. He modified the classic Latin meter to make his hymns appeal more readily to the laity. He used the hymns primarily as a weapon against heresy - especially the rampant Arianism - combining correct theology with elegant and appealing language. His hymns were so instrumental that he is known as the "Father of Church song" and hymns which followed his methods are called "Ambrosian Chant." Ambrose encouraged the laity to sing during the liturgy, as a joyful and solemn addition to prayer. For centuries, the song of the Church continued to be simple, beautiful hymns unaccompanied by any instrument.

The first instrument admitted into Church music was an ancestor of the pipe organ. Legend says that it was introduced by Pope Vitalian in the mid-6th century, but it did not become a popular ecclesiastical instrument until the 12th century - after about a millennium after singing in church became widespread! The influence of music in the Church continues to be strongly felt!
