PASTOR'S CORNER

"I am Who am"

Exodus 3:1-8

In our first Reading, Moses encounters "a bush on fire but not consumed." It is God manifesting His presence...a mystery that cannot be fully explained or understood. In this mystical encounter, God reveals His name: "I am Who am." This means the one who is always there; the One who is always with you. Moses' acceptance of this divine revelation will set him on fire and enable him to set his people free.

Today, we encounter a mystery more remarkable than a burning bush. Calvary is presented to us in the transformation of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. On Calvary, Jesus was on fire for love of you and me. Here at this sacred Eucharist, God wants us to be set on fire for love of Him. It is a fire not to destroy us, but to burn away all those sins and weaknesses that keep us from realizing our full humanity. We are truly ourselves when we produce a life of charity, mercy, purity, and patience.

The world reminds us always of our faults and failings, but offers no solution. The Eucharist reminds us of our potential for holiness and to reflect the very image of God. God always draws near; He is always there not to destroy but to enhance our humanity. As a great saint once wrote, "The glory of God is found in a human being fully alive."

As part of the 2025 Jubilee Year, Archbishop Perez has once again commissioned the **Disciple Maker Index** survey. The survey allows you to assess how you may be doing, both in your discipleship of Christ as well as in your spiritual growth. The aggregate results of the 2025 survey will be compared to our parish results from 2022 and new opportunities will be explored to further improve our parish community.

Tuesday ~ today we celebrate that God became man (John 1:14); attend daily Mass or have a dessert - or both

Wednesday ~ make a small sacrifice today, such as no cream in your coffee, no butter on your toast, or no music in the car

Thursday ~ ask God to show you whatever keeps you from fully experiencing His love; resolve to deal with it before Lent ends

Friday ~ counter pride with authentic humility; pray: "O Jesus, I surrender myself to You"

Saturday ~ consider attending Confession during Lent and pray the Act of Contrition to ask for forgiveness
