DID YOU KNOW? THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS

Aside from the fact that Epiphany - which comes twelve days after Christmas - used to mark the end of the Christmas Season, the "Twelve Days of Christmas" are not really any part of Catholic Liturgy. The song of that name actually derives from a time in England from 1558 to 1829 when it was illegal to be a Catholic, and so the song contains a hidden catechism of Catholic theology.

- * **Two Turtle Doves:** The Old and New Testaments
- * **Three French Hens:** The Theological Virtues (Faith, Hope, and Charity)
- * **Four Calling Birds:** The Four Gospels / The Four Evangelists
- * **Five Golden Rings:** The first Five Books of the Old Testament, the "Pentateuch"
- * **Six Geese-a-Laying:** The Six Days of Creation
- * **Seven Swans-a-Swimming:** The Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit / The Seven Sacraments
- * **Eight Maids-a-Milking:** The Eight Beatitudes
- * **Nine Ladies Dancing:** The Nine Fruits of the Holy Spirit
- * **Ten Lords-a-Leaping:** The Ten Commandments
- * **Eleven Pipers Piping:** The Eleven Faithful Apostles
- * **Twelve Drummers Drumming:** The Twelve Points of Doctrine in the Apostles' Creed





THE LEGEND OF THE CANDY CANE



The **hard candy** reminds us that *Jesus is our rock.* (Psalm 61:2)

The **cane shape** reminds us of a *shepherd's staff* and the shepherd that came to worship Jesus. It also reminds us of how Jesus came into the world to be a shepherd of his people. (Luke 2:8-15 and John 10:11)

The upside-down candy cane forms the letter "**J**" and reminds us of the name of *Jesus* which means "God saves." (Matthew 1:21)

The **peppermint flavor** reminds us of the *gift of spices* from the Wise Men. (Matthew 2:11)


The **white candy** reminds us of *purity and holiness*. It recalls the virgin birth of Christ, the sinless life of Christ and the holy life that Jesus wants his people to live. (Matthew 1:23 and 1 Peter 1:15)

The **color red** reminds us that *Jesus became a real flesh and blood man* and spilled his blood to save his people. (Hebrews 2:14)

The **stripes** remind us of the *lashes Jesus received* when he suffered for us and ultimately bore our sins that we might be healed. (1 Peter 2:24-25)




