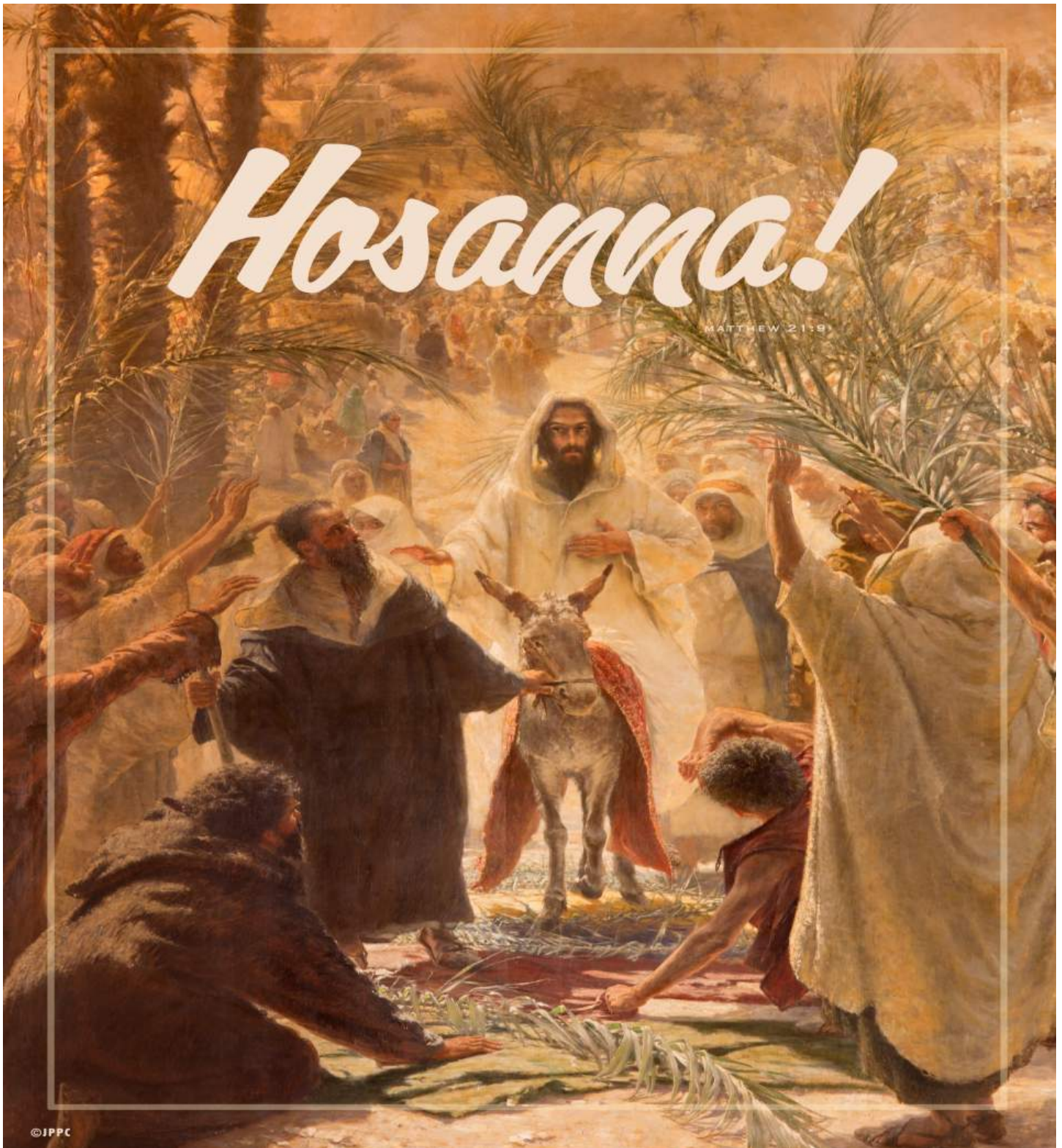

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**"He humbled Himself...to a point of death,  
even death on a cross."**

*Philippians 2:6-11*

The Passion of the Lord proclaimed this Palm Sunday comprises two important points. The first is the event - Christ suffered and died, giving over His body and shedding his blood. The second is the motivation - this can be found in just two words... "for you!"

If we forget the why and the motivation, then Jesus' Passion is just a historical fact, disconnected from our personal lives. As one author put it, "The Passion of remains foreign, unless we enter the narrow door of the "for you." Yes, you and I are the reason this event took place. How do we respond? We respond by faith, and living the life which Jesus died to give us. Respond by showing gratitude, especially by being present with the Lord these coming Holy Days. Let us make a greater effort to fill this house - not just next week on Easter Sunday. Fill this house with great affection, with the fragrance of gratitude, and with the gift of love.

Pope Benedict once wrote: "There is no greater priority than to enable people of our time once more to encounter God." May this be our top priority this week to be with the Lord... by our silence, prayerfulness, and then most especially by our presence with Him who loved us and gave His life for us!

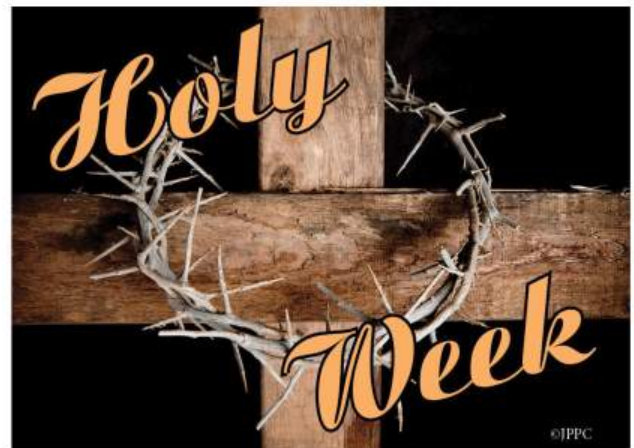

## ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



THANKS to this parish community for the tremendous support for the 2022 St. Hilary Diamond Jubilee Capital Campaign. Seeing the progression of this campaign these past months has been truly a blessing. We have an exciting update; this campaign has raised **\$407,191.25**. Through your prayers and help, we have even surpassed our initial goal of \$350,000. The sooner that the pledges are redeemed, the better it will be for paying for these projects. Of the 229 campaign responses, 141 are now paid in full. *The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, on all the Fridays of Lent, and on Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.*

## **THE BLACK DOT**

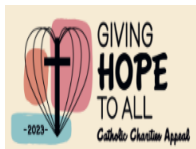
