PASTOR'S CORNER


WELCOME ~ REV. MR. JOSEPH W. BERNAUER

ASH WEDNESDAY IS THIS WEDNESDAY,
FEBRUARY 22, 2023

MASSES are at 8:00am, 10:00am and 7:00pm
(Ashes are given out during Mass)

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age and older are bound to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday, Feb. 22, 2023, on all the Fridays of Lent and on Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday, while the other two meals on those days are to be light.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended.

All are encouraged to participate in Operation Rice Bowl which has aided the countless hungry persons here in the Archdiocese as well as throughout our nation and our world.





Fri., Feb. 24 - Catholics are required to abstain from meat on the Fridays during Lent as a form of penance.

Sat., Feb. 25 - the Bible teaches us to deny ourselves and give instead to those in need. Read Matthew 6:1-4 to learn more about sacrificial almsgiving.


