



PASTOR'S CORNER

“Stay with us.”

The gospel tells us of two disciples in a state of despair. All their hopes in Jesus seemed shattered by His crucifixion and death. We find them walking toward a setting sun, and then a Stranger appears. He walks with them, listening and breaking open the sacred scriptures. As He appears to depart from them, they pray, “Stay with us; the day is over and evening draws near.” The Stranger stays and breaks bread with them and they realize it is Jesus, the Risen Lord.

We all have such stories when our hopes are diminished and shattered. The hard knocks of life happen...perhaps the death of a loved one, betrayal, unexpected sickness, family crisis, etc. In such moments, this same Stranger is walking with us. Jesus waits to hear our prayer, “Stay with us.” He is here, present in the sacrament of the Eucharist. We are called to change direction and walk toward the rising sun, the Son of God. No situation is beyond His reach. Jesus overcame the most impossible situation - death itself. In those dying-like moments of life, He is here to raise you up. As the great Easter prayer reminds us:

“He is the One who broke the chain of death and rose triumphant from the grave. Christ is the morning star who comes back to shed His light on all, the Son who lives and reigns forever and ever.”

Growing Together in Faith: Our DMI Survey Journey

In 2022 and 2025, our parish participated in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) Survey, a tool provided by the Catholic Leadership Institute to help us understand our strengths and opportunities for growth. Your honest feedback has truly provided a clear roadmap for our future.

We are excited to share these key highlights comparing our 2022 and 2025 results:

A Younger, Growing Parish: We are welcoming many new faces! In 2025, **16%** of respondents had been members for fewer than 5 years, compared to **9%** in 2022.

Empowered Leadership: Our community is more engaged than ever. **79%** of you now feel you have opportunities to serve the parish, up from **67%** in 2022.

A Deeper Sunday Experience: The Eucharist remains our heart. **63%** of respondents in 2025 reported growing spiritually from attending Mass, an increase from **59%** in 2022.

Stronger Spiritual Practices: Our personal prayer lives are flourishing. **71%** of parishioners now pray daily, up from **64%** in 2022.

A Rising Missionary Impulse: We are sharing our faith! **64%** of you invited someone to a parish activity this past year, a significant jump from **48%** in 2022.

What an absolutely wonderful gift to be a priest, and to celebrate Mass, preach the Gospel, and administer the sacraments to our youth and elderly and everyone in between. Thank you for allowing me to walk with you in the ways of faith in these many years. You will long be remembered in my thoughts and prayers, as well as at Masses. Please say a prayer for me as I embrace this new phase of priestly life. In closing, I pray God's grace and peace be with you and your loved ones.
