**PASTOR'S CORNER**


**“You are the salt of the earth and the light of the world.”**

Salt was a precious commodity in the time of Jesus; almost as precious as gold. As we know, it was often used to preserve food or for medicinal purposes. Salt brings out the flavor in food; it brings out the best. To call someone “salt of the earth” was the highest of compliments, referring to one’s loyalty as well as durability.

Today, Jesus pays each of us that very same compliment. We are called to preserve the rich tradition of our faith to be lights of hope in times of darkness. 

## ST. VALENTINE'S STORY

Let me introduce myself; my name is Valentine. I lived in Rome during the third century. That was long, long ago. At that time, Rome was ruled by an emperor named Claudius. I didn't like Emperor Claudius, and I wasn't the only one! A whole lot of people shared my feelings.

Claudius wanted to have a big army. He expected men to volunteer to join. Many men just did want to fight in wars. They did not want to leave their wives and families. As you might have guessed, not many men signed up. This made Claudius furious. So what happened? He had a crazy idea. He thought if men were not married, then they would not mind joining the army. So, Claudius decided not to allow any more marriages. Young people thought that this new rule was cruel. I thought it was preposterous! I certainly wasn't going to support that law. Did I mention I was a priest? One of my favorite works as a priest was to marry couples. Even after Emperor Claudius passed his law, I kept on performing marriage ceremonies - secretly, of course. It was really quite exciting. Imagine a small candlelit room with only the bride and groom and myself. We would whisper the words of the ceremony, listening all the while for the steps of the soldiers.

One night we did hear footsteps. It was scary! Thank goodness the couple I was marrying escaped in time. I was caught, however. I was thrown in jail and told that my punishment was death. I tried to stay cheerful. And do you know what? Wonderful things happened. Many young people came to the jail to visit me. They threw flowers and notes up to my window. They wanted me to know that they, too, believed in love. One young woman was the prison guard's daughter. Her father allowed her to visit me in the cell. Sometimes we would sit and talk for hours. She helped me to keep my spirits up. She agreed that I did the right thing by ignoring the Emperor and going ahead with the secret marriages. On the day I was to die, I left my friend a little note, thanking her for her friendship and loyalty. I signed it, "**Love from your Valentine.**"

I do believe that this note started the custom of exchanging love messages on Valentine's Day. It was written on the day that I died, which was February 14, 269 A.D.



### A Proven Way to Grow in Friendship With God

Do you long to feel God's love more deeply but find something holding you back? St. Ignatius of Loyola shared this struggle, inspiring him to create a transformative daily practice. This practice can help you live with greater joy in your journey with Christ:

- \* **Give thanks...***reflect on the blessings of your day; pause to really savor them and offer your heartfelt gratitude*
- \* **Seek clarity...***ask God for the grace to recognize your sins and remove them from your heart*
- \* **Examine your day...***review your actions from waking until now; reflect on how sin crept in, the virtues you may need to cultivate, and areas of your life that need God's healing touch*
- \* **Ask for mercy...***come to God in repentance; His mercy welcomes you back, and Scripture assures us that Heaven rejoices over every contrite heart (Luke 15:7)*
- \* **Resolve to grow...***commit to loving God & others more fully tomorrow; plan how to resist temptation, make an effort to amend relationships, or consider Confession..*



### WHEN THINGS GO WRONG, CHOOSE CHARITY

When difficulties arise, our instinct is often to complain, assign blame, or turn inward with harsh self-criticism. A more constructive response is to choose kindness deliberately, in thought, speech, and actions.

- \* **Practice Kindness in Thought:** Pause and redirect your thinking. Replace them with a steady reminder such as, "This is difficult, but I can respond well." Offer yourself patience.
- \* **Practice Kindness in Speech:** Before speaking, ask whether your words will help or simply vent frustration. When emotions run high, bring your complaints to prayer.
- \* **Practice Kindness in Action:** Focus on what you can do rather than what you cannot control. Express gratitude, offer help, listen attentively, or perform a small, unnoticed kindness.  
Responding with kindness does not ignore problems; it creates the conditions for peace and clearer judgment.


