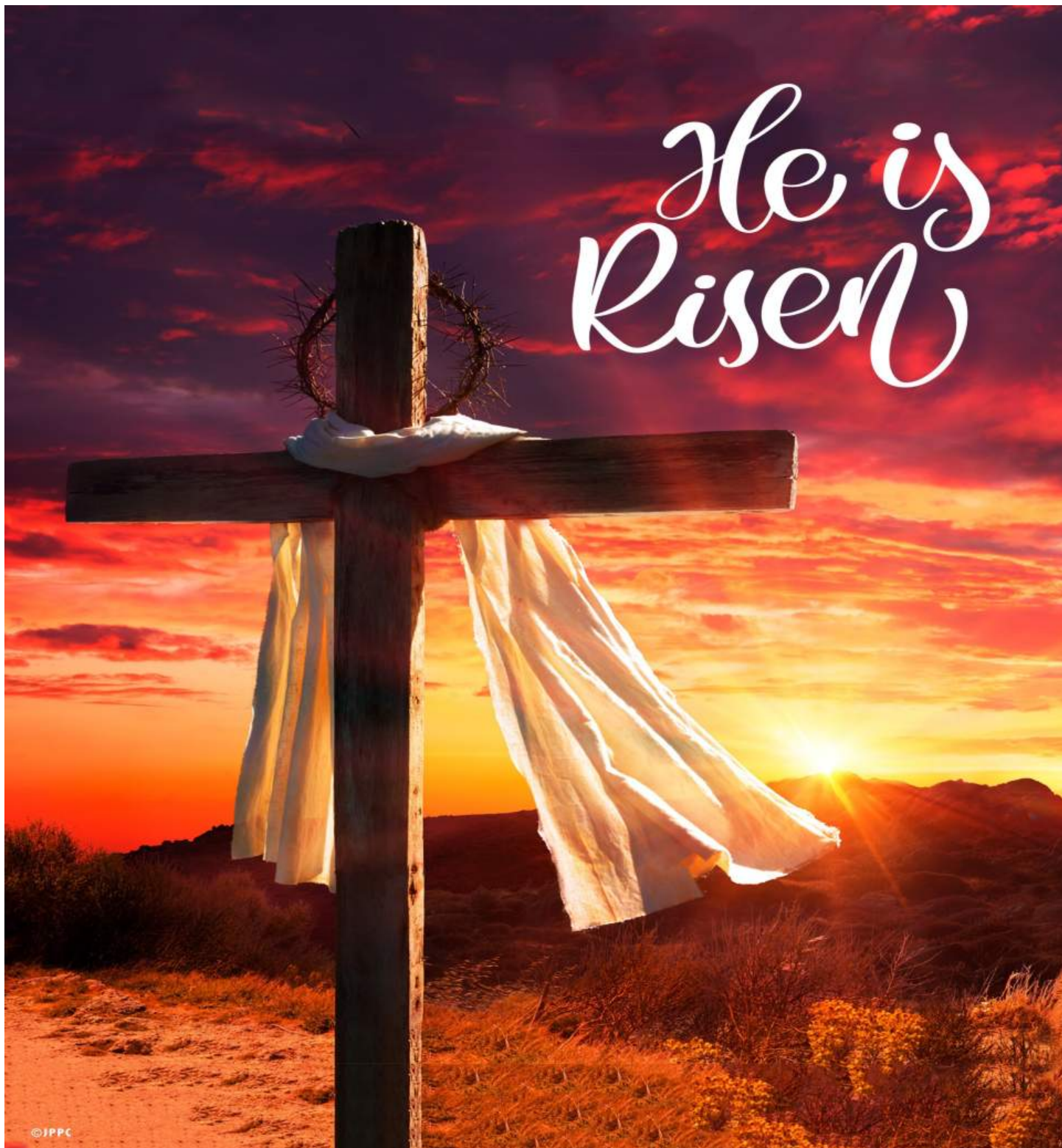

## UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



This coming June, we will complete our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. Currently a total of \$427,176.25 has been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$350,536. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 169 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoyed our new air conditioning system in the Church in summer. Our children and teachers were kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. So, as we are in the second year of our Campaign, I am most grateful for your generosity. As always, the people of St. Hilary always come through! God's grace & peace, Fr. Murray

## KEEP EASTER JOY ALIVE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

**This Easter joy can't be contained to just one day...the Church gives us a whole season to celebrate! Try these ideas to prolong the joy of Easter:**

- \* **Keep a Lenten practice that helped you grow closer to God (small sacrifice, attend extra Mass, acts of charity, etc)**
- \* **Decorate the house by displaying an image of the Risen Christ in your home; put out bouquets of flowers (real or artificial) for the garden in which Jesus rose (John 19:41)**
- \* **Proclaim the Good News by wearing a cross or crucifix, saying grace in public, talking about His grace, and imitating His forgiveness.**

## ALLELUIA! ALLELUIA! HE HAS RISEN FROM THE DEAD!



Our prayers and meditations during this season, which lasts seven weeks from Easter Sunday until Pentecost, can also remind us of the many ways in which, what we commonly refer to as the Paschal Mystery, is not some whimsical story, as some might have you believe these days. (The Paschal Mystery refers to Jesus' Passion, Resurrection, Ascension into Heaven, and sending of the Holy Spirit.) Christ wasn't just some philosopher or prophet but was indeed the Son of God, the Second Person of the Trinity! After His Resurrection, Jesus wasn't a ghost either! One of the apostles, St. Thomas, inadvertently helped provide proof of that when, at Jesus' bequest, he touched His wounds from His crucifixion, after having previously expressed his doubts about our Lord's rising from the dead. After His Resurrection, Christ had a glorified body, one that could move and appear or disappear instantaneously, much as the two disciples discovered when they met Him on the road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13).

When we renew our baptismal vows at Mass on Easter Sunday, we strengthen our faith and our determination to "walk in newness of life" with our Lord, as St. Paul put it so well (Rom. 6:4). With Christ's help, we can free ourselves from the shackles of our sins and share Eternal Life with Him when we pass away. Just as He conquered death, then so can each of us, if we persevere in prayer and in sincerely trying to do His will.

Easter prayers also help us reflect on the fact that these efforts toward holiness will indeed be rewarded in heaven or in hell at the Last Judgment, reaffirming the eternal destination established at our death. Our bodies in heaven will be immortal, pain-free, and able to move at the speed of thought, much like Christ's in the gospel accounts of events between His Resurrection and His Ascension! (Imagine never having to worry about aches and pains again? Or about some craving that will only make you more miserable afterwards?)

In our Easter prayers, let us keep "our eyes on the prize" as we contemplate St. Paul's words that our bodies shall rise in power and in incorruptibility to join our souls if we have attained Eternal Life with God. Happy Easter!
