

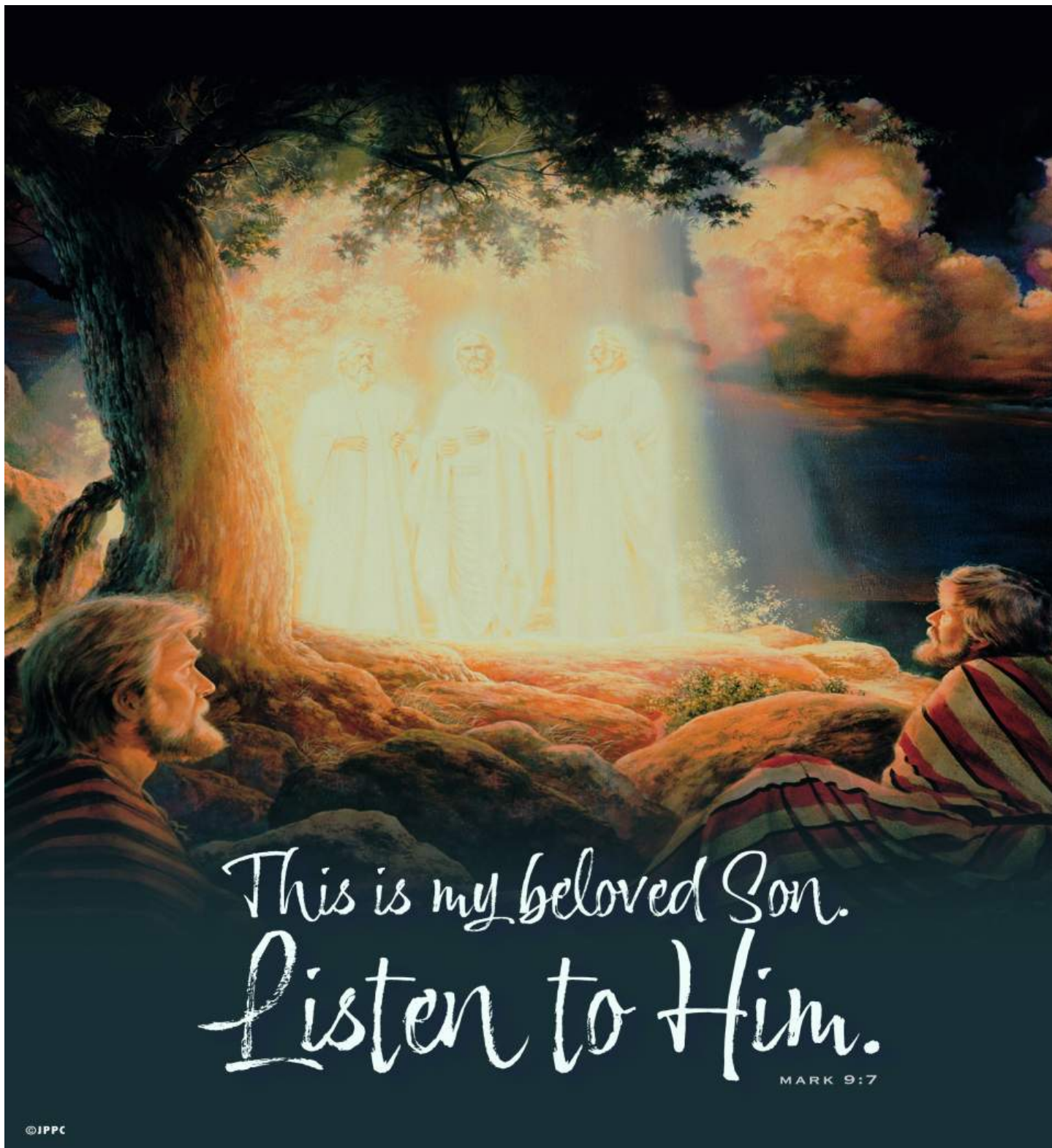

**"This is my beloved Son; listen to Him."**

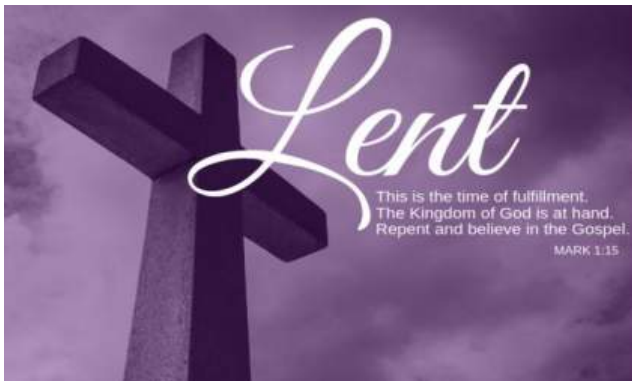
-- Mark 9:2-10

**UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN**



This coming June, we will complete our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. Currently a total of \$427,176.25 has been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$347,508. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 169 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoyed our new air conditioning system in the Church in summer. Our children and teachers were kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. So, as we are in the second year of our Campaign, I am most grateful for your kind generosity. As always, the people of St. Hilary always come through! God's grace and peace.

**THREE PILLARS OF LENT**

The three pillars of Lent are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving (acts of charity). Lent is a realistic down-to-earth time. It's about ashes and the cross. It's about money, food, and how I spend my time. It's about sin and sorrow. It's about life and death.



One of the Prefaces in the 1974 Sacramentary used for Lenten Masses thanked God because "each year you give us this joyful season when we prepare to celebrate the Paschal Mystery with mind and heart renewed." Joyful? That seems strange for Lent.

But it's like an exercise program. At the very beginning, you're sore all over, yet you also feel invigorated, energized, enlivened...and you really feel good about yourself. Your body is made for this.

So it is with Lent. Our penitential practices may be hard at times, but they lift our inner spirit. We're made for more than TV reruns or computer games.

We are made for the unimaginable greatness of God.



**SOME SUGGESTIONS FOR THIS SECOND WEEK OF LENT:**

*Sunday ~ scroll through your cell phone contacts and offer your Communion for whichever person you land on*

*Monday ~ ask God to remind you of His love for you today (it's a prayer He loves to answer); thank Him tonight*

*Tuesday ~ make a small sacrifice today for souls; e.g. no cream in your coffee, no snacks before bed, etc.*

*Wednesday ~ give up worry; write down what worries you and leave it before an image of Jesus and surrender it*

*Thursday ~ pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy for those who have no one to pray for them (<https://www.usccb.org/prayers/divine-mercy-chaplet>)*

*Friday ~ resist "idle curiosity"...don't google trivial questions or follow every browser thread, unless it's important*

*Saturday ~ pray for pregnant mothers and their babies*

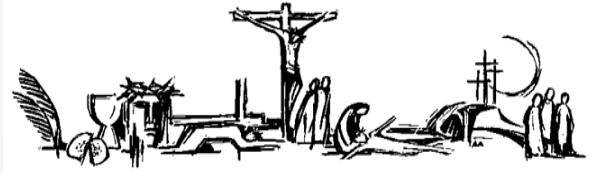
