## PASTOR'S CORNER

### "I am the Gate"

-- John 10:1-10

A traveler to the Holy Land came across shepherds watching over their flock. In the distance he noticed enclosures or pens that shelter the sheep at night. He also observed there were no gates or doors at the entrance. When he asked the shepherd why, the shepherd responded, "I am the gate." At night, the shepherd would lay across the entrance, keeping the sheep in and the predators out.

In the gospel, Jesus reminds us that He is the gateway to find rich pastures of hope, healing, mercy, and forgiveness. By Baptism, we have entered the sheepfold of the Church, following the voice that calls us to embrace the truth about ourselves and know the potential for virtuous living. There are many voices calling out to us today... voices that do not call us to truth but a corrupt version of it, and a false image of freedom. Social media and TV seek to corrupt our young people's morality and perverted images of love and freedom. The world's image of love is complete self-indulgence, and freedom means to give full reign to your passions.

What are we to do? St. Peter reminds us to "return to the Good Shepherd, the guardian of your soul." Look to the Cross and contemplate true love in its most radical form. True freedom is not doing what you want, but doing the good as God sees the good. St. Peter says, "Save yourselves from the corrupt generation and follow the Voice of the Good Shepherd." Psalm 23 reminds us that God guides us in right paths to find restful waters, and He refreshes our souls.

Please say a prayer for me as I embrace this new phase of priestly life. In closing, I pray God's grace and peace be with you and your loved ones.
