"I am the Resurrection and the Life"

-- John 11:1-45

The remaining weeks of Lent will have St. John as our spiritual guide. He weaves together beautiful stories of Jesus' encounter with people who are broken, fearful, and despairing. The Samaritan woman found refreshing water in Jesus' mercy. The blind man not only had his physical sight restored but his spiritual sight as well. He now saw Jesus as Lord of his life. In the gospel of this 5th Sunday in Lent, Jesus delivers Lazarus from the most hopeless situation...death itself.

We all experience similar moments that we find in these stories. More than ever, we, like the people in these stories, must turn to the Lord. 
