

#### PASTOR'S CORNER

#### "Lord, have mercy on me, a sinner."

A great Scripture scholar, Reverend Raymond Brown once wrote that if no change occurs as a result of prayer, then one has not really prayed. Prayer is the lifting up of our hearts and minds to praise God. It is to give Him thanks for His mercy and patience with our unconverted side of our lives. Realizing that, at times, we are poor in spirit, poor in love, and poor in charity and mercy, we come before the Lord. We come not to praise ourselves, like the Pharisees in the gospel today, but in the spirit of the tax collector who, realizing his poverty, prayed "Have mercy on me, a sinner."

In an interview, Pope St. Francis said, "I am a sinner but I trust in the infinite mercy and patience of Jesus Christ." He models the true spirit of prayer. In the end, it is not how we compare with others as a measure of virtue. It is how we compare with God. When we compare ourselves to God, we can all say, "Have mercy on me, a sinner."

At every Eucharistic celebration, great changes take place. By God's spirit, bread and wine are transformed and changed into the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. May the fruit of our prayer be seen by the changes that occur in our lives. May we leave behind our old selves, and may our true selves shine forth as we bear the image and likeness of Christ.

#### RANDOM FACTS ABOUT DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME...

- \* Ben Franklin first proposed the idea of daylight saving time in 1784 but it didn't become law in the U.S. for the first time until 1918. Then it was repealed in 1919, and it wasn't reinstituted nationwide until 1974 as a way to cope with the energy crisis. It still isn't mandated by federal law, though, so not all states participate.
- \* The period of time covered by daylight saving time has changed a few times in the U.S. Prior to 1986, it ran from the last Sunday in April and to the last Sunday in October. In 1986, it changed to the first Sunday in April through the last Sunday of October. The last change began in 2007, with daylight saving time currently running in the U.S. from the 2nd Sunday in March through the 1st Sunday in Nov.
- The time changes occur at 2:00am, not midnight. It's thought to be a time when the fewest people & businesses will be impacted, since most people will be at home, after most restaurants and bars will already have closed, and before most early shift workers need to be at work.
- \* It's daylight "saving" time, not daylight "savings".
- \* There's some scientific evidence that our bodies don't handle the time change all that well. One article cites a study that bodies naturally adapt as dawn comes earlier and earlier each day in late winter; but the change to daylight saving time interrupts that gradual process (much like a punch in the face for our Circadian rhythms).
- \* The only states that don't currently participate in the time change are Arizona & Hawaii (although there's a small donut-shaped area in the Navajo Nation in Arizona where daylight saving time is observed).


