## PASTOR'S CORNER

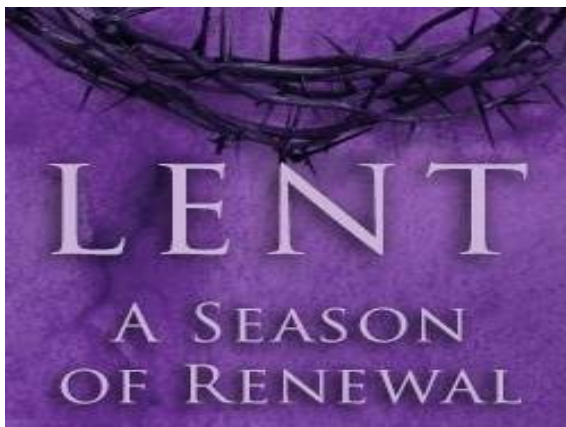
**“God has given us the ministry of reconciliation.”**

We've all heard the expression, “I will forgive but not forget.” It means the refusal to let go of past hurts...we hold onto festering memories; waiting and ready to vent. This kind of attitude is what St. Paul calls the “old things.” This is what the world calls us to do.

In the first Reading, God says, “I have removed your reproach.” Reproach means to constantly bring up the past; to bring up and remind others of past failures. God does not relate to us like that. He does not keep score or bring up the past. He offers healing forgetfulness, like the father and his prodigal son.

God our Father longs for our return to His house of mercy. No matter how great the sin...no matter how long it has been since a good confession...God's mercy is greater than any sin of ours. The readings today “call us back to our senses.” The Lord waits for us in the sacrament of reconciliation to forgive and forget the past. Yet we are called to do the same in our relationship with others. We, too, as St. Paul writes, are to be “ministers of reconciliation.” We pray that others can be confident that the same mercy can be found in us.

As part of the 2025 Jubilee Year, Archbishop Perez has once again commissioned the **Disciple Maker Index** survey. The survey allows you to assess how you may be doing, both in your discipleship of Christ as well as in your spiritual growth. The aggregate results of the 2025 survey will be compared to our parish results from 2022 and new opportunities will be explored to further improve our parish community.
