
PASTOR'S CORNER

"With the Lord there is mercy"

There is a shocking statement on the lips of Jesus today, "Whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven." How can this be since Jesus' whole mission was centered on mercy and forgiveness? The Scribes and Pharisees show us what is taking place here. They refuse to recognize the authority of Jesus to forgive sin, since only God can forgive sins. Yet that is the issue; they cannot admit that Jesus is the incarnation of God Himself. Their hearts are hardened, their minds are closed, and their eyes are blind to the very power of God.

Yet despite what is seen, people claim Jesus is in company with the devil. This is unforgivable sin - not that Jesus will not forgive, but they refuse to recognize Him as the very source of forgiveness. What becomes unforgivable is the refusal of one to ask for God's mercy. Jesus revealed a God who is rich in mercy and slow to anger. There is no sin greater than His love and mercy. His mercy endures forever and awaits us all in the great Sacrament of Reconciliation.

UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



During this month of June, we will complete our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. Currently a total of \$427,176.25 has been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$354,313. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 173 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoyed our new air conditioning system in the Church in summer. Our children and teachers were kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. So, as we are in the second year of our Campaign, I am most grateful for your generosity. As always, the people of St. Hilary always come through!




