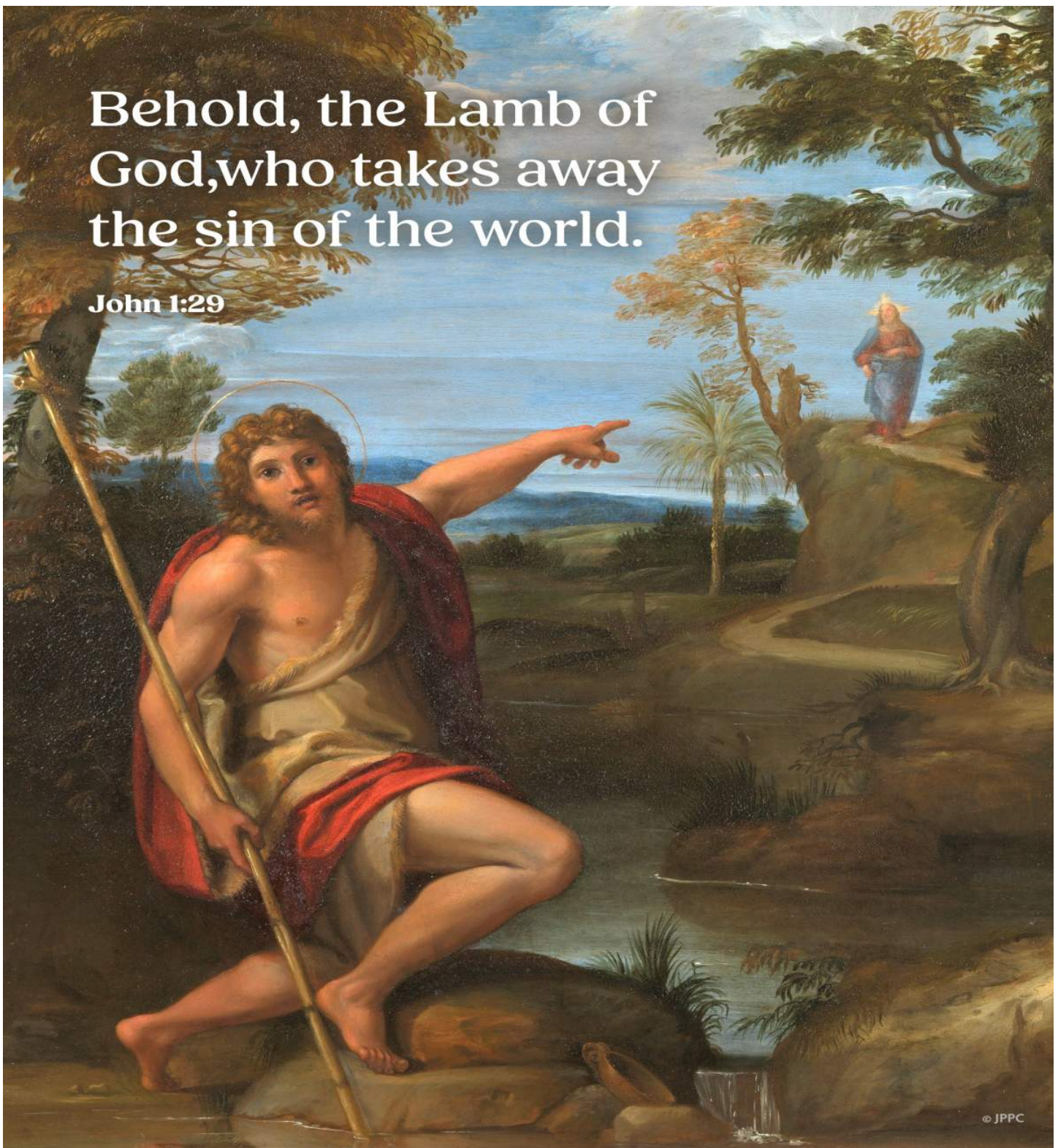

### "Behold the Lamb of God"

In the darkness of human events, St. John the Baptist tells us a new light is rising. The child Jesus has grown to manhood; He is on a rescue mission to rescue all of us from self-doubt, as well as powers and circumstances that make us feel less human. This mission is summed up in the words he describes to Jesus, the Lamb of God. He is reaching back to sacred tradition when Moses led Israel out of slavery. **We have just entered Ordinary Time  
in our Liturgical Year...**



### **What Ordinary Time Means in the Catholic Church**

Because the term “ordinary” in English most often means something that’s not special or distinctive, many people think that Ordinary Time refers to parts of the calendar of the Catholic Church that are unimportant. Even though the season of Ordinary Time makes up most of the liturgical year in the Catholic Church, the fact that Ordinary Time refers to those periods that fall outside of the major liturgical seasons reinforces this impression. Yet, this Ordinary Time is far from unimportant or uninteresting.

### **Why is Ordinary Time Called Ordinary?**

Ordinary Time is called “ordinary” not because it is common but simply because the weeks of Ordinary Time are numbered. The Latin word “ordinalis” which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word “ordo” from which we get the English word “Order.” Thus, the numbered weeks of Ordinary Time, in fact, represent the ordered life of the Church, the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) or in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ. It’s appropriate, therefore, that the Gospel for the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time always features either John the Baptist’s acknowledgement of Christ as the Lamb of God or Christ’s first miracle ~ the transformation of water into wine at the wedding at Cana. Thus for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives.

**There’s nothing “ordinary” about that!**
