



PASTOR'S CORNER

"God so loved the world that He gave us His only Son."

There is nothing like a good contest and fierce competition. Sports fans, especially this time of year, are on the edge of their seats as they prepare for the Phillies home opener, the NCAA March Madness, and so on. The gospel today reminds us of the greatest competition - a bloody fight between the forces of good and evil. It was the greatest contest in the history of the world because "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son."

Jesus Christ was sent on a rescue mission. Lifted high on the Cross, He overcame the power of evil and the many ways it intertwines with our lives; all those unmanageable forces that affect us. The darkness of our sins, jealousies, addictions, hopelessness...these forces nailed Christ to the Cross. His wounds healed our wounds in Resurrection.

Today at the Eucharist, the wounded and risen Christ comes to lift us up again. He is here to lift us up and out of all that is dark in our life. In nature, the light of the day is ever-increasing dispelling the darkness of winter. May we welcome the true light, the light of Christ, that dispels even the darkness of death. In another week, we will pause to remember two great saints - Saint Joseph and Saint Patrick. They witnessed to life's greatest truths, that real love is measured by what we're prepared to sacrifice. May we, like them, become God's handiwork - called to live a life of good deeds which Christ has prepared for us in advance.

UPDATE TO THE ST. HILARY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

This coming June, we will complete our two-year Capital Campaign. As previously noted, our original goal was \$350,000. The generosity of our parishioners has been overwhelming. Currently a total of \$427,176.25 has been pledged. Of that amount, we have collected and deposited \$347,948. Of the 231 families who have pledged, 168 families are paid in full. All of our projects have been completed, and all bills are now paid, thanks to you! I hope you enjoyed our new air conditioning system in the Church in summer. Our children and teachers were kept cool with our brand new school air conditioning system. Our new lighting in the parking lot and the new beautiful side Church doors have been a most welcome addition as well. So, as we are in the second year of our Campaign, I am most grateful for your kind generosity. As always, the people of St. Hilary always come through! God's grace and peace.

Friday ~ make an additional, small sacrifice of your choosing and pray for the unborn children and their mothers


Saturday ~ give others the gift of your presence; ask about their work, interest, family, etc. and listen attentively


